Under 12 Major - 4½ out of 6 (Final 28-30 Dec.)  
Under 14 - no qualification necessary (Final 13-14 Dec.)

## SECTIONS

### Age limit sections

Under 8 / Under 10 / Under 12 / Under 14 / Rated Sections

Players must have been under the section age on 31.8.2025

For juniors or adults., ECF Rapidplay Ratings will be used.

### Which section should I enter?

All results will be submitted to the ECF for rating. Most juniors enter the age limit sections. These correspond to School Years, i.e. Under 8 is for Year 3 or below, Under 10 for Year 4 or 5, Under 12 for Year 6 or 7 and Under 14 for Year 8 or 9. You are allowed to enter an older age group if you wish.

## ENTRY FEES

**All sections:** £45 if paid in advance and ECF junior gold member or higher; £55 if paid on the day or not ECF members.

**Confirmation of Entry** - Please note receipts are not normally sent unless a stamped addressed envelope is enclosed.

## TOURNAMENT DETAILS

Each player will be allowed 30 minutes per game. Help will be given to those not used to clocks. This is not a knockout tournament. Swiss pairings will be used. All competitors play in every round.

All sections will be played to ECF Rapidplay rules using chess clocks. The ECF publishes the Rating list on their website. If you wish to have your Rating details (Rating Reference Number, Name, Club(s), Rating(s), Rating Category) withheld from the website version, please contact the ECF, [www.englishchess.org.uk](http://www.englishchess.org.uk). The organisers reserve the right to merge sections, in the event of a section receiving insufficient entries.

Parents and friends are welcome to stay, but should note that only stewards and players will be allowed in the playing areas. We do not provide any supervision of children between rounds, so you must stay to look after your own children or arrange for another adult to be responsible for your children.
